Welcome to Brighton College Prep Kensington, a happy and vibrant school for boys and girls aged 2 to 13.


As a part of the award-winning Brighton College family of schools, Brighton College Prep Kensington nurtures a culture of kindness, where the personal happiness of children is our priority.


The academic success of Brighton is due to excellent, innovative and well-planned teaching. We are looking for individuals who foster a passion for learning and who can demonstrate an ability, and genuine desire, to develop pupils to their fullest potential.

Many teachers joining the school have a proven track record of effective teaching, having obtained excellent public examination results with previous classes. However, we are also equally happy to appoint candidates who are currently on a PGCE, or candidates with no formal teaching qualification. Several members of our teaching staff have pursued different career paths, and have made the move to teaching at a later point. We view this diversity as a strength.

We seek candidates with a demonstrable ability to thrive in an intellectually invigorating environment. The ability to inspire children is key, as is a willingness to support the ambition and values of the school and to be involved in a breadth of school life. Successful candidates will be self-reliant and adaptable, with high levels of initiative.

Candidates should have a strong academic record, including a good degree in a relevant subject. Those without teaching experience must be able to demonstrate a genuine interest in young people and teaching. We will look for evidence of the capacity to contribute to the broader life of the school, and for evidence of passion and enthusiasm for the relevant subject.

For the right candidate, there could be the opportunity to work in one of our international schools in due course.





About the role

We are seeking exceptional Heads of Subject who have extensive experience in teaching Key Stage 2, 3 and possibly 4 and 5. Brighton College Prep Kensington pupils have an academic ability ahead of the national average and enjoy the school's focus on challenge and child-focussed learning.

The successful candidate will not only be able to deliver exciting and effective learning in the classroom but will also liaise with other Academic Heads of Departments to develop the school's overall academic strategy. They will also contribute to the school's co-curricular and pastoral programme of activities. This is an excellent opportunity for someone to develop their career towards a future senior leadership position and to work in the unique environment of a founding school.

Responsibilities

- · Demonstrate outstanding teaching;
- Ensure outstanding learning;
- Ensure the subject curriculum is appropriately structured from EYFS to Year 8;
- Provide opportunities for learning outside of the classroom;
- Ensure pupils are entered for appropriate external competitions.
- Foster a collaborative, effective, and solution-focused team;
- Monitor and appraise the effectiveness of teachers in the subject team.
- Deliver an incremental, dynamic and inspiring EYFS, KS1, KS2 and KS3 curriculum;
- Review, publish and implement an annual departmental development plan;
- Communicate and oversee the plan and its associated responsibilities;
- Implement departmental and relevant whole-School policies;
- Keep up to date with curricular change and reform;
- Ensure pupils are thoroughly prepared for Senior School Assessments;
- · Lead department planning in the light of change and reform;
- Ensuring that effective tracking of pupil progress is in place throughout all Key Stages;
- Identify underperformance and measure the impact of intervention programmes;
- In conjunction with the Head of Learning Support, make sure that all SEND requirements are met;
- Attend Academic Committee meetings and disseminate relevant information;
- · Coordinate the department's recommendations for the awarding of prizes;
- Coordinate non-classroom supplementary learning experiences for pupils;
- Prepare and manage an annual department budget;
- Plan for, provide and maintain the physical resources necessary for learning and the delivery of chosen syllabuses and courses (including books, past papers, file shares, department websites, furniture, equipment);
- Ensure that the department is well-presented and conducive to learning (e.g. tidiness, use of wall space);
- Help maintain a calm and purposeful atmosphere around the School, in and out of classrooms;
- Attend all relevant meetings appropriate to your role, as specified by the School;
- Carry out, following consultation, any other reasonable task determined by the Head.
- Contribute fully to the co-curricular and pastoral life at BCPK;
- Act as a Pastoral Tutor;
- Promote the co-curricular ethos and life of the School, including the teaching of Games
- Set high expectations of enthusiasm for learning, punctuality and commitment;
- Be responsible for the day-to-day leadership and management of the department;
- Be prepared to teach throughout the Middle and Senior Departments;
- Foster links with Senior Schools and relevant associations;
- Liaise with other Heads of Department, to maximise opportunities for cross-curricular links:
- Ensure that the departmental learning environment is stimulating, well-resourced and includes a range of interactive displays that not only reflect pupils' learning but can also be used as an independent learning tool.
